

# Fanny Chapman Pool Rules

## 2024 General Pool Rules

*Member account photos are required for Pool admittance*

**Fanny Chapman Pool will comply with all mandated Federal, State and Local health guidelines for the safety of our Membership and Staff.**

- 1. NO SWIMMING IS PERMITTED IN ANY POOL UNLESS A LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY. Socializing with on-duty lifeguards is strictly prohibited.**
- 2. ATTIRE** - Swimmers must wear clean and appropriate swimwear. Swimming in cutoffs, long pants, or street clothes is not permitted. Infants, toddlers, and others in diapers are mandated by PA State Law to have rubber pants over the swim diaper and under the swimsuit.
- 3. LOCKER ROOMS** – We ask your assistance in keeping them clean and functional by reporting any problems to our front desk staff. Children of the opposite sex, under the age of 5, may accompany their parent or caregiver into the parent’s or caregiver’s designated locker room. We also have a family restroom for your convenience.
- 4. TODDLER POOL** - Children under age 6 or at/under the height indicated on the sign are welcome to swim in the baby pool. Children in the baby pool area must be under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian at all times.
- 5. SUPERVISION** - *Children under age 12, and all children in the baby pool area, must be under the direct supervision of an adult at all times. After 5PM, all children under age 14 must be accompanied by an adult.*
  - **Personal floatation** devices that are attached to the body are not allowed at any time in any pool.
- 6. WATER DEPTH** - Children accompanied (1:1) by an adult are permitted in water (depth) up to the adult’s shoulders. Children under age 14 (not on the swim team) are required to pass the Deepwater Test in order to swim in water above their shoulders or use the diving pool.
- 7. DEEPWATER TEST** - Swimmers must successfully swim two widths of freestyle in the Main Pool with their face in the water (rotary/side breathing) and tread water for one minute.
- 8. UPPER POOL** - All members and guests age 18 or older are welcome on the upper deck, and in its pool, during general swim times. Swim lanes are to be shared while complying with social distancing.

## 9. **Adult Lap (Upper) Swimming**

- Lanes 3,4,5,6 in the Upper Pool will be used for lap swimming.
- Up to 4 circle lap swimmers may occupy a lane at a time.
- Lap swimmers may only occupy a lane for maximum 55 minutes or as the reservation states.
- Lanes 1&2 will be for recreational swimming
- Lane 7 will be considered a Wading Lane.

10. **POOL TOYS** – Personal pool toys will be allowed only in the Toddler Pool.  
Any toys left will be discarded.

11. **DIVING** - Diving from the side of the pool is restricted to forward dives only in designated areas. All diving off the diving boards will be with one bounce. Divers must exit pool via ladders.

- **Diving Boards:** Only one on a board at a time. People waiting to go off the high dive wait at the bottom of the ladder for the person on the board to go off.

12. **FOOD & DRINK** – Only water is permitted in the pool complex, **No food is allowed.**  
**Chewing gum, drinking alcohol, coolers, and glass containers are not permitted in the pool complex at any time.**

13. **CONDUCT** - The following behavior is not permitted:

- Hanging, tugging, or sitting on lane lines or section ropes
- Running, pushing, dunking, excessive splashing, or unruly behavior
- Smoking is not permitted in the pool complex, playground, or parking lot.
- Management has the right to remove patrons disrupting the health and safety of others.

14. **PREMISES** - Skateboards, skates, roller blades, bikes, and scooters are not permitted on pool premises. Management has the right to limit the number of patrons in the facility in compliance with PA State Regulations. All members must vacate the pool complex no later than 5 minutes at the end of their reservation time.

15. **WEATHER** - The swimming pools and decks will be cleared of all persons (in compliance with PA State Regulations) during thunderstorms for at least 30 minutes, and perhaps longer, if adverse weather conditions continue.

16. **LOST & FOUND** - Pool management is not responsible for lost or stolen possessions.  
For the 2024 season, any clothing items left at the pool will be donated or discarded.

17. Pool Management has the authority to enforce these and reserves the right to respectfully request a member to leave the pool area for noncompliance or inappropriate behavior.
